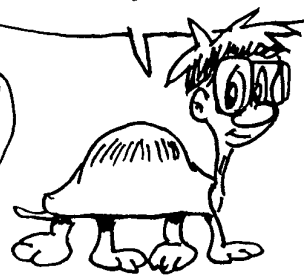

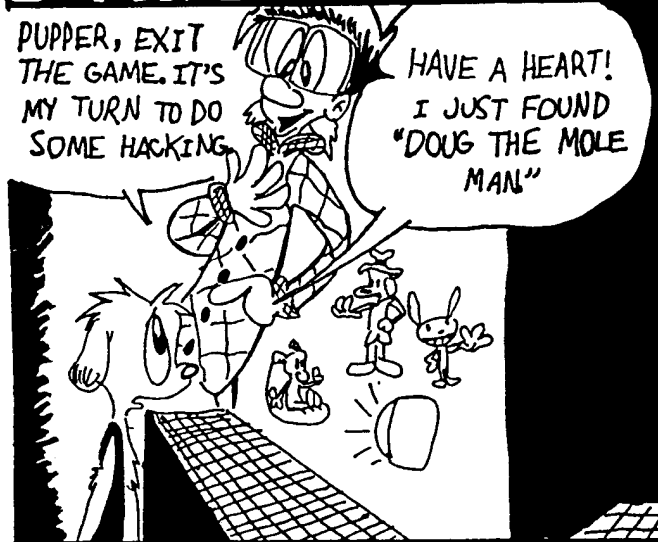
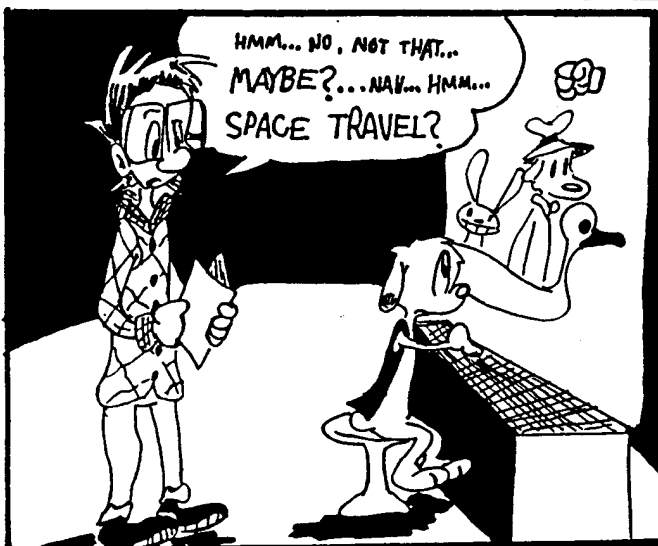


JUST A THOUGHT... (by David)
